Master Gardener Course Scholarship Application

The purpose of the J. Powell Smith scholarship program of the Lexington County Master Gardener Volunteers is to support the Master Gardener education of individuals dedicated to facilitating the educational work of the local Consumer Horticulture Agent, by delivering research-based information to the citizens of the state.

Eligibility:

- 1.) Resident of Lexington County
- 2.) Successfully enrolled in the Clemson Extension's Master Gardener class in Richland, Lexington, or Aiken counties. (Or Online South Carolina Master Gardener class.)
- 3.) One letter of recommendation attached to application
- 4.) Master Gardener from Other States wishing to transfer to SC (*Note: Requires letter of recommendation from MG State Coordinator to Terasa Lott, SC MG State Coordinator.*)

Recipients of past LCMGV scholarship awards are not eligible to reapply.

Awards:

- 1.) A scholarship of \$150.00 may be awarded to four (4) eligible applicants as determined by the scholarship committee.
- 2.) The scholarship(s) will be paid directly to the recipient(s).

Application:

- 1.) Complete the required scholarship application form.
- 2.) Submit the letter of recommendation.
- 3.) The Scholarship Committee is the final authority for the selection of the recipient.
